

Heavy Haul Transport #3 Completes First Leg

SPMT traveled Northbound, arrived at Rt. 14 Tamuning at 3:42 am

Tamuning, Guam – Thursday, February 16, 2023 – The third heavy haul transport of components for the new Ukudu Power Plant completed its first leg, arriving at Rt. 14 in Tamuning near the ITC building. The SPMT traveled Northbound on Rt. 1, Marine Corps Drive.

Throughout the transport, alternate routes and live tracking were made available at **poweronthemove.org**, and one lane northbound remained open. As transports and returns continue daily, the public is encouraged to use alternate routes to avoid traffic delays. The public can also sign up for PDN SMS alerts throughout the transport at guampdn.com under the Text Alerts tab.

The 22-axle Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) carried 175.8 metric tons of cargo. The transport convoy included a Guam Police Department escort, G4S Security, and Smithbridge trucks. The second leg will be announced shortly.
