

Return of SPMT to Port Delayed Until Tuesday at 7 pm

Expect Traffic Delays, Lane Closures on Rt. 1, Southbound

Dededo, Guam – Monday, February 6, 2023 – The return trip to the Port Authority of Guam of the Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) previously scheduled for this evening has been rescheduled to tomorrow evening, Tuesday, February 7, starting at 7 pm with an ETA of 4 am, Wednesday, February 8.

The SPMT will travel Southbound from the site of the new Ukudu Power Plant in Dededo across the Micronesia Mall, on Rt. 1 until it turns onto Rt. 11, Cabras Road in Piti. It will be moving at a speed of around 3-5 miles per hour. Guam Police Department units and Smithbridge trucks will be part of the transport convoy once again.

The Guam Police Department asks the public to continue to drive with caution. Log on to poweronthemove.org for real-time tracking and alternate routes. One Southbound lane on Rt. 1 will be open.
