

Second Leg of Heavy Haul Transport #8 Set for Tonight at 9 pm

SPMT stopped at ITC area Tuesday morning; will resume move to Ukudu

Tamuning, Guam – Wednesday, March 8, 2023 – The eighth heavy haul transport will resume tonight, scheduled to depart Rt. 14 at 9 pm. The Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) left the Port Tuesday evening and traveled northbound on Rt. 1, Marine Corps Drive, stopping overnight at the ITC area in Tamuning. It will make its way northbound on Rt. 1 to the site of the new Ukudu Power Plant in Dededo.

The transport convoy includes a 16 and 18-axle SPMT, a Guam Police Department escort, G4S Security, and Smithbridge trucks.
