

## **Next Heavy Haul Transport Scheduled for Tonight** *SPMT will depart Port at 8 pm, head Northbound on Rt. 1*

Piti, Guam – Wednesday, February 15, 2023 – The third heavy haul transport of components for the new Ukudu Power Plant has been scheduled for this evening at 8 pm. Tonight’s move will be the first leg of a two-leg transport spread over two days. It will leave the Port Authority of Guam traveling Northbound on Rt. 1, Marine Corps Drive.

The 22-axle Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) will be carrying 175.8 metric tons of cargo, the heaviest of all the transports. It will be the center of the transport convoy, including a Guam Police Department escort, G4S Security, and Smithbridge trucks. The SPMT will end its first leg near the GPA Transportation Shop in Tamuning, near the ITC building.
