

# SPMT Returns to Port

*Trailer stalled several times, made it to destination at 1:24 pm*

Dededo, Guam – Wednesday, February 8, 2023 – The Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) had some mechanical issues during its return from Ukudu to the Port Authority of Guam. Just after 7 am, the trailer experienced a fuel line issue approximately one mile from the Port and was stalled on Rt. 1 in Piti. The fuel line was subsequently repaired under two hours and the SPMT was on the move once again when the trailer experienced a hydraulic issue, causing the SPMT to stop a second time, around Quenga St. in Piti, just short of the entrance to Cabras Road and Rt. 11.

It stalled once more as it turned onto Cabras Road but was running shortly after. At approximately 1:24 pm, the SPMT made it back to the Port Authority of Guam where it will undergo maintenance, diagnostics, and additional repairs.

Guam Police Department units managed traffic where there were minor traffic delays, as both a southbound and northbound lane were available for drivers to traverse.
