

SPMT Completes First Leg of Transport

Trailers resting near GPA Transportation Shop in Tamuning

Hagåtña, Guam - Monday, February 13, 2023 – The Self-Propelled Modular Trailers (SPMTs) carrying heavy haul components for the new Ukudu Power Plant completed its first leg of the transport just a little after midnight.

The transport convoy which included two SPMTs, a 16-axle and 18-axle carrying 138.5 metric tons and 125.7 metric tons of cargo, respectively, departed the Port Authority of Guam at 2:30pm and arrived at the Intersection of Rt. 1 and Rt. 11 within an hour. Despite experiencing hydraulic issues on Rt. 1 in Asan, the trailers made it to the destination of its first transport leg on Rt. 14 in Tamuning, more than two hours ahead of schedule.

The convoy included Guam Police Department units, G4S vehicles, and Smithbridge trucks laying out and picking up steel plates for the SPMT to traverse over. G4S will continue providing security for the SPMTs while the trailers rest overnight near the GPA Transportation Shop in Tamuning. The second leg of the transport will be announced tomorrow.
